

Admissions Appeals Statement: The E-ACT Burnham Park Academy

For admissions in the normal round from year 6 to year 7:

Year 7 places, commencing September 2014, will be allocated and notified to parents in a formal offer by letter from Buckinghamshire County Council Admissions Team on 3 March 2014 where a single secondary place will be awarded.

The E-ACT Burnham Park Academy, at present, follows the Buckinghamshire County Council appeals procedure and any appeal for a year 7 place under the normal progression from primary to secondary school should be made through the LA.

For late applications for year 7 places, please contact Admissions and Appeals who will advise you as regards availability.

For admissions to Post 16:

All 16 offers are conditional on receipt on GCSE results. Students wishing to appeal against the offer received should register this appeal with the Academy by September 12th 2014.

For in year admissions appeals:

If you wish to appeal for a place in an oversubscribed year group the appeals process is currently administered by Buckinghamshire County Council Admissions and Appeals who will be able to advise applicants upon the process and the timescale involved.
